Chaplain's Corner

RECOGNIZE GOD'S PRESENCE

2 Corinthians 5:21. God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might be come the righteousness of *God.* John had not experienced God's presence in his life for a long time. John said "God must be mad at me because of the way I've been living, for everything I touch goes wrong. I have so many bad things against me, how can I possibly expect God to come back in my life? How can I turn things around?"

The answer was explained this way. Suppose, John that you owed a very large amount of money, say \$20,000.00 and the debt came due in full? What would you do? One possibility is to pay the debt off. But what if you didn't have the money and had no prospects of every getting it. Second, you could go into bankruptcy and suffer the loss of everything you had. Third, you could go to the person whom you owe and ask to have the debt completely forgiven. In human experiences today, what are the chances of that ever happening? That kind of forgiveness would be very rare.

You know that's what God offers you, free and full forgiveness for your sins. You cannot repay God, nor can you some how do enough good deeds to balance off your sins. Why? Because God is Holy and even one sin is an offense to Him. God's eyes are too pure to look on evil. It is possible for God to completely forgive you because Jesus Christ, the righteous Son of God, took upon Himself the punishment that you and I deserve for our sins. God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become righteous, and have ever lasting life.
