## **CHAPLAIN'S CORNER**

### **FORGIVENESS**

MATTHEW 18:21, 22 Then Peter came to Jesus and ask. Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times? Jesus answered I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.

U. S. Army Airman, Jake D. was the bombardier on one of the last B-25's to launch from the carrier U.S.S. Hornet. After successful completion of their mission to bomb Japan their aircraft out of fuel, crashed in China. The Japanese captured him and others of his crew. He was beaten, half-starved and at times placed in solitary confinement. He witnessed three of his buddies executed by firing squad. He said then that the bitterness and hate of my heart against these Japanese captors is more than I can bear. He was taken to Tokyo where he remained imprisoned through out the war. In 1944 the Red Cross gave him a Bible. Jake begins to read it for the first time. When Jake read Romans 10:9, his life was changed forever. He said, at that very moment God gave me the grace to confess my sins to Him. God saved me for Jesus sake. I realized that these cruel Japanese did not know anything about my Savior and Christ was not in their hearts. I ask God to forgive them and I prayed for God to give me the strength to do the same. On August 20th 1945 Jake was rescued by American paratroopers.

Four years later Jake returned to Japan as a missionary. He started churches through out Japan. One of his first followers was a man name Mitsuo Fuchida, who was a lead pilot on the attack of Pearl Harbor, Dec. 7 1941. Jake and Mitsuo were good friends. Can you forgive others who have sins against you as Jake did? Jesus said while he was dying on the cross for our sins, "Father forgive them for they do not know what they are doing". Luke 23:34

Now may our God with love and peace be with you and your family in Jesus name, Amen.
